NON-PROFIT LIAISON COMMITTEE

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Non-Profit Liaison Committee is commissioned by and reports to the Advisory Board of the Grant County Community Foundation to facilitate collective problem-solving in support of the region's non-profit organizations and to ensure the foundation maintains a deep and thorough understanding of the issues and needs affecting these organizations and the people they serve.

Committee Responsibilities

- Facilitate the planning and implementation of any unified fundraising initiatives on behalf of the region's non-profit organizations (i.e. the "Give Grandly" fundraising day).
- Identify opportunities to support the region's non-profit organizations through collective problem-solving and/or public policy; make recommendations for policy or action by the foundation.
- Identify needs and facilitate the planning and production of education and training programs to advance non-profit organizations' capacity to achieve their missions.

Committee Chairman Responsibilities

- Enlist members of the committee, seeking members from the Advisory Board and the community with broad knowledge of and influence with the region's non-profit organizations.
- Plan and facilitate meetings and activities of the committee.
- Report to the Advisory Board concerning the committee's plans and progress.
